It will be illustrated with slides, and interposed with readings from the works of some of the writers. The talk is by Roger Evans, former County Historic Buildings Officer and a Bucks Historic Churches Trustee, with slides from his collection. The readings are by Alfred Bradley, who has presented poetry readings at the National Portrait Gallery, Gainsborough's House in Suffolk, and Rydale Arts Festival in Yorkshire. They will delight the ear with extracts from Shakespeare, Milton and Cowper to Rupert Brooke and Betjeman, while the eye is treated to pictures of some beautiful and interesting Bucks buildings - including some churches!
